#### (SBU) The Secretary's Meeting with South Korean Foreign Minister Kyung-wha Kang <u>Tuesday, June 16, 2020, 10 a.m., 1 hour</u> Foreign Minister [KAHNG kyin-wah]

**LAST INTERACTION:** You last spoke with Kang on September 15, 2019, about the relationship among the major countries in the northeastern Asia region. The DPRK is always a concern, and issues with China and Japan are omnipresent, as the growth of both Republic of Korea (ROK)'s and China's economies, respectively, have altered the power dynamic with Japan that existed for much of the second half of the 20th century.

### **KEY OBJECTIVES**

- (SBU Health) How South Korea controlled COVID-19: South Korea has done a spectacular job of containing COVID-19. Even though the first South Korean case of COVID-19 was announced on the same day as the first case in the U.S. in January 2020, as of May 12, 2020, they have had less than 11,000 deaths attributed to the disease and under 300 deaths. They achieved this in a country with a population of over 51 million (a little under one-sixth (1/6) of the U.S. population), and where many people in urban areas live with much less personal space.
  - (SBU Health) What were the precise steps that South Korea took in order to achieve this tight control over COVID?
  - (Unclassified) Could you please share with us some key processes that might work over here in the U.S.?
  - (SBU Deliberative Process) Could you please identify how we can get ahead of ridiculous rumors about how the coronavirus is a hoax that is all about trying to control people? Or is South Korea not such fertile ground for this kind of thinking?
  - (SBU Privacy or PII) When I edit this document after I have requested that the final output format be changed, does that mean that the format of the new version of the document will change?
